## **About the Plumber:**

- 2. How much will the water meter installation cost?
- 3. How long will installation take and how long will my water be shut off?
- 4. Are you familiar with what I am planning to do, and have you done similar projects for others? (sub-meter for tenants, sewer deduct meter, etc.)
- 5. Do you offer a warranty on your work?
- 6. Do you have any references that I could contact?
- 7. Are you familiar with **Flows.com**, their extensive offering of water meters, and the spectacular support they provide? (we sure would appreciate the mention! ©)

### **About the Water Meter:**

#### Where is the best location to install the meter(s) for the intended use?

Considerations for water meter location include:

- Ease of Installation and reading.
- The size of the pipe must be matched!
- Is the pipe vertical, horizontal, or somewhere in-between?
- Is the location indoors, outdoors, or in an outdoor pit?

#### What unit of measure should my water meter use?

Match what is on your water bills

#### Do I need a check valve?

Are they required by our municipality

#### Should I install isolation valves before and after the meter?

#### What will my flow rate be?

Can you measure it with a bucket test or using an external (ultrasonic) meter?

Are you aware of any local laws or certifications involved when selecting and/or using a water sub-meter?
